## Grant Application

Friends of Bedlam is the association for former members of the Edinburgh University Theatre Company (and its predecessor the Edinburgh University Dramatics Society).

One of the roles of FoB is to support EUTC projects, both financially and in offering the support and advice of former members now working in the arts and cultural industries.

FoB sets aside a proportion of the funds donated by former members to fund extraordinary EUTC projects or purchases – that is to say projects or purchases not covered by existing EUTC / EUSA budgets.

Any EUTC member can apply for funding from FoB. Funding applications should be made on the form below and submitted to the EUTC President, who will pass them on to FoB.

FoB will only fund official EUTC projects that have been approved by the Company. FoB will only fund future projects – ie projects that are yet to happen. FoB will not generally completely fund a project or purchase – we will expect the EUTC or an external body to cover at least 50% of the project's costs.

The FoB committee consider grant applications as they come in and we will respond within 2 weeks, if there has been no response within the 2 weeks then the application has been successful.


